Astoria Warrenton Crab & Wine Fest features 50 booths operated by Oregon wineries. Participating wineries are invited to submit entries to the official wine competition ahead of the event. The 2026 competition included more than two dozen varietals, with red wines representing approximately two-thirds of the entries. Both the festival and competition are organized by the Astoria-Warrenton Area Chamber of Commerce. A panel of five judges with diverse wine industry backgrounds evaluated the entries.

# THE JUDGES



## JEFF MARTIN

In 1990, Jeff moved to the north coast and became the executive chef at the Astoria Golf & Country Club. After his time at the club, he then became general manager at the Wayfarer restaurant in Cannon Beach, where he continued his achievements in cooking competitions.

In February of 2001, Jeff and his wife Laurie, who is a native Astorian, opened the Silver Salmon Grille in downtown Astoria. The Martins hosted many wine makers dinners at the restaurant throughout the years. Jeff also served as the chef for wine makers dinners at The Cellar on 10th in Astoria. The opportunity to taste such a broad number of wines while planning the pairing of the courses helped educate his pallet.



## CYNTHIA GIEROK

Cyndi has been in the wine industry since 2006, starting by pouring wine for special events. She didn't know much at that time, but when she tasted a delicious Pinot Noir from Willamette Valley, she knew her destiny. She has been involved in events such as Pinot Camp, IPNC, and have had the honor to judge in wine competitions showcasing Northwest Wines. She was deemed Pinot Princess from her friend David Adelsheim. She looks forward to judging the wines in this year's competition.



## KERRY MCDANIEL BOENISCH

Kerry McDaniel Boenisch is an author, speaker, wine judge and "Wine Sisters Cheers to Change" Vlog co-host with Regina Jones Jackson. She relishes working in her barn selling vintage furniture @dirtvinewinevintage and is currently working on her fourth book, *Fall Down, Stand Up, Learning From Loss Amidst the Vines— The Beginners Guide to Grieving, Empty-nesting and Finding Joy*. Her three books are *Vineyard Memoirs, Dirt+Vine=Wine and Intertwined— Grief, Gratitude and Growing a Vineyard*.



## NICOLE BARTO

Nicole has always been intrigued by wine. She still remembers the first bottle of wine she purchased while in college. It was a cabernet sauvignon from Chateau St. Michelle. "It opened my horizons to a new world. I realized a bottle of wine was not just another bottle of alcohol." In 2009, her husband's job took them to smack dab in the middle of Russian River Valley, Ca. then to Paso Robles/Edna Valley Area. It was destiny. When they moved back to Washington state, she came across a post online about certifications in wine with a comment about the Certified Wine Judging Program. It is a 3-year program through the American Wine Society. The program had led her to pursue the WSET 2 and 3 certifications. Nicole finished the Certified Specialist of Wine last year.



## CHRISTOPHER HAYES

Christopher Hayes is a Portland-based wine professional with over 20 years of experience in the international wine trade. His career has focused on portfolio management, sales leadership, and management as well as market development across a diverse range of Old World and New World producers.

Known for his analytical palate and broad category knowledge, Christopher has extensive experience assessing wines across styles and appellations. He is particularly interested in wines that express regional character, balance, and a clear sense of place.

# BEST OF SHOW

## BEST OF SHOW WHITE

### 3 GOATS WINERY SCHEUREBE, 2024, YAMHILL-CARLTON

The panel praised this Scheurebe for its crisp, clean profile and strong structural balance, with vibrant acidity and expressive fruit carrying smoothly from nose to finish. Its layered complexity makes it both refreshing and well defined in the glass. Judges also noted its versatility with food, highlighting seafood as a natural pairing, along with cheeses such as cheddar or Emmental and richer dishes like pork roast.

## BEST OF SHOW RED

### STONE GRIFFON VINEYARD MOURVEDRE, 2022, COLUMBIA VALLEY

Judges described this Mourvèdre as expressive on the nose, showing concentrated aromas of black fruit alongside gentle notes of pepper, savory meatiness, and earth. Primary flavors are well integrated, creating a seamless transition from aroma to palate. Silky tannins and a rounded mouthfeel provide balance and finesse, while a long finish carries layers of savory, earthy character and ripe fruit. The panel noted the wine's complexity and felt it represented the grape's character particularly well.

## BEST OF SHOW PINOT NOIR

### RIVER'S EDGE WINERY BARREL SELECT PINOT NOIR, 2021, ELKTON

The panel noted classic varietal aromas, opening with bright raspberry and tea leaf before evolving into earthy forest and mushroom notes. On the palate, vibrant red fruit is supported by lively acidity, creating a balanced structure that carries through to a long finish. A silky mouthfeel and layered complexity led the judges to describe it as a beautiful and well-balanced Pinot Noir with clear expression of the varietal.

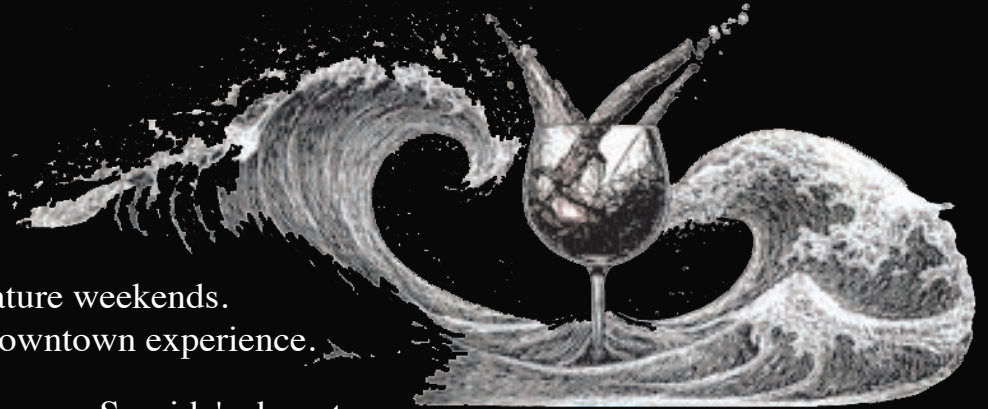

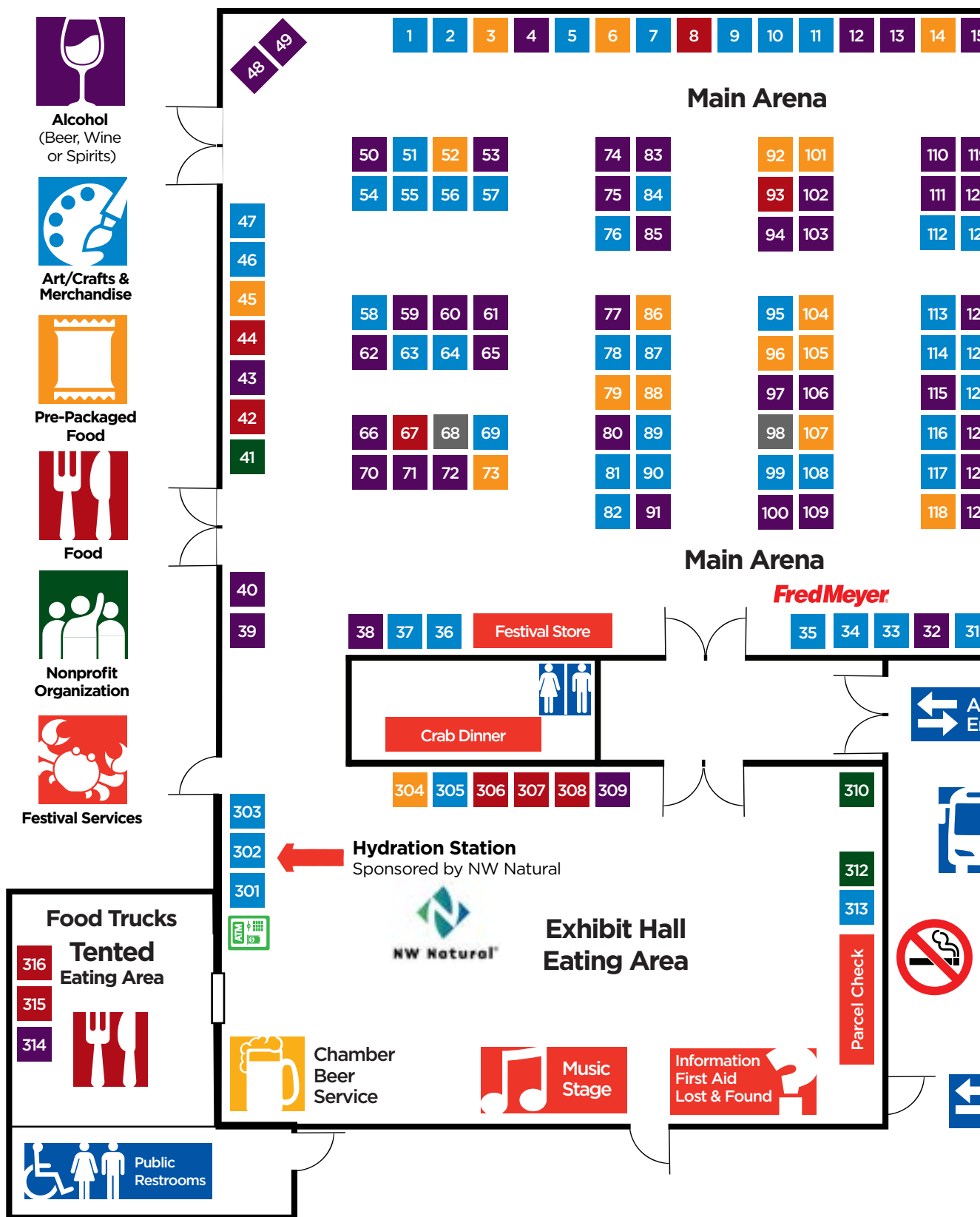

# THE HISTORY

**44TH ANNUAL • 1981 - 2025**

In the autumn of 1981, Chamber members Dan Andriesian, Bill Pitman, Jim Durham, Bobbie McCallister, Jean Anderson, Chuck Farmer and Dorothy Comstock were charged with bringing people to the area in the off season.

The committee came up with the idea of a crawfish festival, and soon decided that "Crab and Seafood" had a more appealing name. Dan assumed the helm amid many comments of "hairbrained" and grumbings of wasted time and money allocated that first year. Andriesian continued to plan, for "The Great Astoria Crab Feed and Seafood Festival" and in a moment of optimism, ordered 800 crabs for the dinner!

As it turned out the one-day event held on March 27, 1982, in a 10,000 square-foot building (the current Red Building) drew an estimated 6,000 people. The 800 crab dinners sold for \$7.50 and they were gone by 5:30 p.m. There were 30 booths offering food, Oregon wines, and crafts, and the Rotary Club featured a beer garden. There were tours of commercial and charter fishing boats, and films of local sea life. The USCG 44-foot motor lifeboat and the CCC Forerunner were tied up at the pier so people could look at those boats close-up.

The festival would be a yearly celebration, moving to several places as it grew. It was at Pier 1 warehouse, Pier 2 in a new building, a Tongue Point Hanger, Warrenton City Park, Camp Rilea, the Hammond Mooring Basin, and finally settled in the Clatsop County Fairgrounds in 2002. We can conclude that "hairbrained" ideas have a positive way of working for this chamber as long as there are people that work to make it happen!

The festival is a big part of this community, and the community is a big part of the festival's success. The Astoria-Warrenton Area Chamber of Commerce appreciates the continued support from all our vendors, contractors, sponsors, volunteers and attendees. Thank you for being a part of our first four decades. Let's do it again next year!
